CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS & PARENTS

Any player representing Brymbo Cricket Club is expected to show a high level of sportsmanship and play the game fairly and in accordance with the laws. Whilst wanting to develop a winning attitude, it must be emphasised that:

- **Gamesmanship and “sledging” are unacceptable for players**
- **Aggressive involvement from parents is unacceptable**

The following Code of Conduct will, therefore, be expected of players representing the club and their parents/guardians:

TEAM TACTICS - Matters relating to team tactics are the sole responsibility of the Coach and Team Captain and should not be publicly criticised by players, parents or non-participants.

1. **BATTING ORDER** - The Coach and Team Captain will decide the batting order.
2. **SELECTORS' & UMPIRES' DECISIONS** - Players, Parents and spectators **MUST** accept without question decisions made by selectors and **ESPECIALLY** by the Umpires during a game.
3. **DISCIPLINE** - **ALL** matters relating to team and individual discipline both on and off the field are the responsibility of the Selectors, Coaches and Managers. This includes behaviour off the field and when travelling to and from matches.
4. **SIGN ON ACCEPTANCE FORM** - Any player accepting an invitation to play for the club does so in the knowledge of the above and ACCEPTANCE AND COMPLIANCE OF THE CONTENTS OF THIS CODE. All players and parents must sign the acceptance of this code when signing on with the club.
5. **WITHDRAWAL** - The Coach/Manager may withdraw any player from any match at any time and for any reason.
6. **SUPPORT FOR COACHES & MANAGERS** - At club level young cricketers need the support and encouragement of their parents. It is positively detrimental to their personal and cricketing development if they witness a parent or supporter publicly contradicting what they have been told by their Coach and Manager, however unhappy the parent may be about any specific incident.
7. **OUT OF BOUNDS** - PARENTS SHOULD ALSO RESPECT THAT THE PAVILION AND DRESSING ROOMS ARE OUT OF BOUNDS DURING HOURS OF PLAY.
